

LA DADA STYLE GUIDE

Title

The title should be brief and to the point.

Subtitle

The subtitle should summarize the content of the article without repeating the title. It mustn't be more than three lines long.

Author

The author's name, surname(s) and profession (position and place of employment) should be provided.

Article

The article should be between 7.000 and 12.000 characters long, including spaces. It will not be proofread, meaning the author is responsible for assuring quality writing.

Images

We require that articles include two images. They should preferably be originals and in landscape and colour format.

We reserve the right to use said images freely and without limits, under the following Creative Commons licence: Attribution-ShareAlike 4.0 International (CC BY-SA 4.0). https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-sa/4.0/deed.en

The Archivists-Records Managers Association of Catalonia (AAC) requests that the rights of use of said images be assigned to it, so that it may undertake dissemination actions including, but not limited to, material design for its online platforms, social media accounts and publications, as well as for any advertisements it creates to promote its activities.

These images will be included in the AAC's image bank, which is for internal use only and thus not open to the general public.

The subsequent assignment of documents of an equivalent nature will be governed by the terms set forth herein.

Images must be saved as JPG files and have a medium resolution of at least 1.600 x 1.200 pixels.

Submission

Articles should be submitted in Word format by email to publicacions@arxivers.com.

Images must be submitted as digital files. The image caption and authorship must also be provided. Otherwise, the images will be understood as being the property of the author of the article or as having been legally assigned to him/her.
